There are three categories, plus a Peoples' Choice on the night of the concert

* Mike Silverwood Memorial Song Writing Award 1st \$150

* Instrumental Award 1st \$150

* Under 19 song or instrumental Award 1st \$150

* Peoples Choice Award 1st \$50

Eligible songs and tunes must be composed by a resident of Tasmania, must not have been entered in any other competition. They should be suitable for performance at the live concert. A composer can select a performer of their choice.

Entries to be submitted on a CD, clearly showing the name of the entry, with name, address, and telephone number. Entries will be judged on the submitted CD only. Please indicate if performer is not the composer.

Entry fee is \$10 per piece. Free if current member of FFT.
